The Estonian Swimming Federation in cooperation with Estonian Aquatic Sports School invites you to the
I Open Baltic States Championships in artistic swimming!

Venue: Turu 10, Tartu, Tartu region, Estonia, 51004

Pool dimensions: Swimming pool meeting with dimensions 25×50 m with depth 1.20 - 1.85 m..

Competition area 25×25 m, with depth 1.85 m.

Competition programme (preliminary):

November 25th – arrival,

November 26th -27th – competition,

November 28th – departure.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make changes to the schedule. The exact schedule will be sent to registered participants within one week after the registration deadline.

Please, in the registration application, indicate the phone number of a contact person who can be added to the group in WhatsApp.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

Rules: The competitions are held in accordance with FINA rules 2017-2021

Competitors: National teams of the Baltic countries (Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia) and national team/clubs from other countries.

In each age group one national team/club can enter up to 12 participants (if a team enters a Mixed Duet, then it can add one or two participants according to the age of the competitive category).

Referee: Anton Rzhakov

Age groups:

- AG8 (born in 2014 and younger);
- AG10 (born in 2012 and younger);
- AG12 (born in 2010 and younger);
- AG15 (born in 2007-2010);
- Juniors (born in 2004-2007);
- Seniors (born in 2004 and older).

Each sports organization is allowed to register:

- AG8, AG10, AG12 and AG15 – figures only;
- AG8 and AG10 - 1 Solo, 1 Duet, 1 Mixed Duet, 1 Team and 1 Combination;
- AG12 and AG15 - 2 Solos, 2 Duets, 2 Mixed Duets, 1 Team and 1 Combination;
- Juniors and Seniors - 2 Technical/Free Solo, 2 Technical/Free Duets/Mixed Duets, 1 Free Team, 1 Highlight

Competition events and awards:

AG8 and AG10:

- Figures: 100%;
- Free routine (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Team): 100%;
- Free Combination 100%.

AG12 and AG15:

- Figures: 100% + Free routine (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Team): 100%;
- Free Combination 100%.

Juniors and Seniors:

- Technical Routine (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet): 100%



- Free routine (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Team, Highlight): 100%

The awards will be held in two categories:

- Among the national teams of the Baltic countries (Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia);
- Among all participating teams (national teams / clubs).

Medals and diplomas will be awarded for 1-3 places.

All AG8 and AG10 athletes will be awarded diplomas for participation.

Time limits:

- For AG8, AG10, AG12 and AG15: Solo 2:00 min., Duet/Mixed Duet 2:30 min., Team 3:00 min., Combi 3:00 min.
- For Juniors and Seniors: Tech. Solo: 2:00, Tech. Duet/Mixed Duet 2:20, Free Solo: 2:15, Free Duet/Mixed Duets 2:45, Free Team: 3:30, Highlight: 3:00.

The timing error can be 5 seconds.

AG8 and **AG10** figures will be sent in a separate document along with the invitation and entry form.

Participation fee – 35 €

If competitor participants only in figures session, then his participation fee is 15 €.

Competitor can take part in both figures sessions (for example can take part in AG8 and AG10) if he meets the age criteria. In this case, the payment is calculated from participation in two events (Figures + Figures = 30 euros).

In the Free Routines competitor has the right to compete in only one age category.

Each sports organization is required to provide:

- **National team – at least 2 judge;**
- **Club – at least 1 judge.**

In case the organization does not provide judge, the fine is 50 euros.

Music:

For the performance we ask to send the audio files via wetransfer (www.wetransfer.com) to competition@evk.edu.ee no later than November 11th, 2022.

The music files must be submitted electronically via the Internet in mp3 format *Fina Rule AS15.3 Method 2.

Each performance must be named “event_program_name of the competitors/team_name of the club_national federation.mp3”.

For example:

or

We also ask you to bring a good quality music on USB media with you.

Note: All issues not addressed in this guide will be resolved by the competition referee in accordance with FINA competition regulations
